### If You Use Bill-Pay at Your Bank, Order Your Check by Mid-February

If you are using a bill-pay system at your bank to generate a check for payment of your dues, it sometimes takes quite a while for the check to get to us. February is a short month as well. To be certain your check will arrive on-time, please request it from your bank by mid-February. The late fee is now \$25. In order to avoid interest and late fees on your account, we must receive payment by March 1st.

### Reminder of How to Pay Dues Online

Paying by check is the least expensive option for the association. However, for your convenience, credit card payments can be made online 24/7. To make a credit card payment online:

- Go to [www.indianpeaks.org](http://www.indianpeaks.org)
- Under the "Owners" tab on the left-hand side of the screen, click on "Pay Dues Online"
- Click the link under "Pay your Dues Assessment"
- Enter the amount you want to pay and the account number for your week. Your account number is listed on your owners' statement.

### Interval International Points Program Available to Indian Peaks Owners!

Some owners have told us that they are finding it more difficult than in the past to trade their week for another week through exchange companies. That's because the system for trading at Indian Peaks has been based on the antiquated "week for a week" model. Newer timeshare companies and vacation clubs that are usually associated with high-end hotels use the more modern "Points Program." Points programs give owners the flexibility of shorter stays and unlock the ability to trade with other, newer hotel timeshares that our owners are currently blocked from trading into.

Your board of directors has signed an agreement with Interval International so that Indian Peaks owners can now join the Club Interval Gold Point Program. All of the 2 bedroom weeks at Indian Peaks have been assigned points and we are working on the 3 bedroom weeks.

### **Indian Peaks Sales Program**

Our on-site sales program is up and running and we are meeting with owners and guests weekly at our Saturday Welcome Meeting to talk with them about opportunities to purchase weeks at Indian Peaks. She can check with all owners of the week you are interested in to see if they want to sell.

### **Can't Use Your Week This Year?**

If you aren't able to use your week this year and you don't want to deposit it with an exchange company, you

have options! If you'd like to earn some money toward the payment of your dues, consider placing your week on our rental program. Just email us to tell us you are interested and we will email you back the specifics. Details are also listed on our website via [indianpeaks.org/rentalprogram.htm](http://indianpeaks.org/rentalprogram.htm).

All we need is written approval of the terms and conditions listed to place your week into the rental program.

If you can't use your specific week and prefer to travel at another time during the year, we are happy to try to "transfer" your week. Weeks are available for transfer on a first come first serve basis. Weeks may only be transferred to another comparable week. Weeks are only accepted for transfer within a year of arrival. The cost per transfer is \$100.00. We are almost always able to work out a solution so that you can come to visit with us as long as your dates are flexible. Should you be interested in a transfer please email us your request with three possible transfer dates.
